## **MATERIAL LIST FOR PASTEL CLASS**

### **Paper:**

Large sheets of Canson Mi-Tiente paper, 19 1/2"x 25 1/2" I suggest black, grey, blue and tan. (\$2.50 each sheet)

### **Pastels:**

There are 4 types of pastels. Hard, soft, (1/2 stick blocks or rounds), pastel pencils, and pan pastels, these are all sold individually and in sets.

### **Beginners:**

Faber-Castel or Derwent pastel pencil set (12) color set (around \$20.00)

Rembrandt or Unison or Holbein soft pastel set (15-18) sticks (around \$45.00)

Or you can buy the soft pastels individually. You will need this basic palette:

White, Black, Light Red, Dark Red, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Light Green, Dark Green, Light Yellow, Yellow Ochre, Orange, Light purple, Dark Purple, light brown, Dark Brown.

REMEMBER: THE REASON THEY HAVE SO MANY COLORS IN A SET IS BECAUSE YOU NEED THEM CORRECT COLOR CHOICES!

### **OTHER MATERIALS:**

Plastic table cloth for 6' table

2 sticks of medium vine charcoal

Magic white eraser

1" blue painters tape (found in home depot)

Baby wipes for hands, or wear plastic gloves

Reference material, photos, printed in black and white and color, 8x10"
