MATERIAL LIST FOR ACRYLIC

Available at Hobby Lobby in Coral Springs, and Jerry's Artarama.

PAINT:

LIQUITEX, heavy body or soft acrylics or **GOLDEN** acrylics. (good paint for good results!)

- **BASIC PALETTE:** Titanium White, (8 oz.) Sap Green Permanent, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Alizarin Crimson, Cad. Red Med., Cad. Yellow Med., Cad. Orange, Yellow Oxide, Burnt Sienna, Black
- **BLENDING MEDIUM/RETARDER**

BRUSHES:

#14, #12, #8, #6, #2 filberts ,

(1) 2" synthetic brush

SUPPORTS:

(2) 12X16" canvas for traditional work, (2) 16x20" or larger for expressive work.

PALETTE:

Stay-wet palette, (11x14" or larger and paper, or, Freezer Paper and blue tape. Newspaper table to cover. (Freezer paper is found in Walmart on bottom shelf near aluminum foil).

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

VIVA paper towel (this brand), publix bag for garbage

1 spray bottle

Palette knife, (metal)

Container for brushes

Apron or old shirt

1-2 pastel pencils for lay-out work on canvas, red or green

Plastic tablecloth

Sketch pad, notepad, 6B pencil, Carry Bag, or rolling craft bag, a good attitude!
