MATERIAL LIST, OIL PAINTING

Available at Hobby Lobby, Michaels Craft Store, Coral Springs, or, Dick Blick, 2384 N. Federal Hwy., Ft. Lauderdale. Dick Blick has the best deals. PLEASE download Hobby Lobby or Michaels 40% off coupon.

OIL PAINTS:

Winsor-Newton, Rembrandt, Grumbacher. Do not buy student grade paint!

BASIC PALETTE: Titanium White, (8 oz.) Sap Green, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Alizarin Crimson, Cad. Red Med., Cad Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Burnt Sienna, (4 oz. size). **MEDIUMS:** LIQUIN MEDIUM or GAMBLIN SOLVENT-FREE GEL (this is a hard to open jar. Please open and place about 2" in a glass jar with a screw top for class).

ADDITIONAL PAINTS: Acrylic black, Acrylic white (large size)

CANVAS:

11x14" for traditional work, 16x20" or larger for expressive work

PALETTE:

Freezer paper from Publix found near aluminum foil or other disposable palette. please avoid paper plates. Blue tape for securing palette to table, or scotch tape.

BRUSHES:

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

VIVA paper towel (this brand) flat, no waffles, very soft

Gamsol Turp. (odorless, non-toxic) or Turpenoid

Glass or metal container for Turps. with tight cover, at least 8oz. size (screen inside type is best).

Palette knife, offset, metal not plastic

Container for brushes

Apron or old shirt

Disposable gloves, recommended, sold in CVS or Walgreens

Baby wipes for clean up

1-2 pastel pencils for lay-out work on canvas, red or green

Sketch pad, note pad, 6 B pencil, eraser, carry bag

Plastic bag for used paper towels
