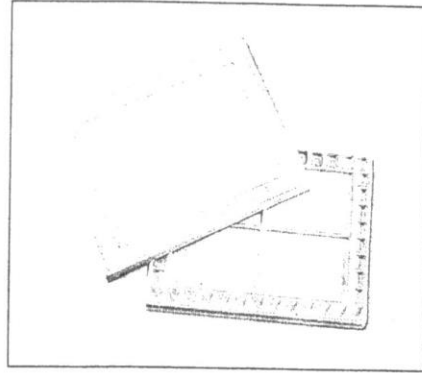

Supply list:

Paints (Any Brand will do):

Thalo Blue
Ultra Marine Blue
Indigo
Cadmium Red Light
Alizaron Crimson
Cadmium Yellow Light
Yellow Ochre
Burnt Sienna
Hooker's Green Deep or Sap Green
DO NOT GET WHITE

Watercolor palette with cover. Something like the image below. 12" x 16"
Do not buy the Tom Lynch Palette the # of wells will vary.



1 pad watercolor paper – 140 lbs. Cold press 12"x 16" (do not get a watercolor block.)

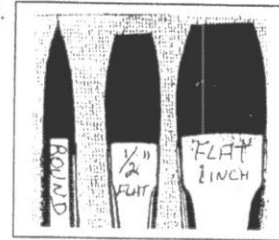
3 watercolor brushes (soft hair) – a 1" flat and a 1/2" flat and 1/2" round.

1 regular pencil

1 kneaded eraser

Paper towels or cheap napkins

Small sketch book – 5"x 7" or 8" x 10"



Each artist has favorite colors and a special way to use them. You must be comfortable with colors. However, you may want to experiment with my shades without discarding your existing palette. Painting does not require a huge selection of colors. Remember that the best shades are made from mixing just a few colors together.

If you already have been painting with watercolors bring whatever supplies you already have and any artwork that you are working on.
