Session Times

Morning **AM:** 9:00 am -12:00 pm
Afternoon **PM:** 1:15 pm - 4:15 pm

Full Day: Select one AM and one PM camp. Supervised lunchtime between AM and PM camps is included in full day camp. Campers bring their own lunch.

Classes for ages 6-9 are divided into fun weekly themes that allow students to discover all different ways of creating through painting, sculpture, mixed media and much, more!



Cirque Du Soleil

Artists will use their imaginations to design collages, sculptures and paintings inspired by the circus. Get carried away creating whimsical works of art!

Life Under the Sea

This class lets artists experiment with different paper and painting techniques to learn about color, composition, texture and shapes, all while exploring life under the sea.

Making a Masterpiece

Learn from the masters in this class, where students spend the week recreating famous works of art inspired by master artists such as Picasso, Van Gogh and Frida Kahlo.

Surreal Reality

Students create surreal pieces that are both imaginative and fun! Explore works from surreal artists and use this as inspiration when painting and drawing.

The Wild Things

Take a walk on the wild side in mastering the basics of creating animals using pencil, paint and mixed media. Your art work will explore the natural world with a different type of animal featured each day.

Pop Art

Jump into designing pop art! Use bright colors to create fun works inspired by everyday images and comic books.

Art Around the World

Become a world traveler and discover different cultures through art. Students will use a variety of techniques and materials as they explore different destinations around the globe.

Sculpture Creations

Spend the week creating and exploring the world of sculpture. Wood, paper, wire, cloth, clay and found objects will be worked into creative masterpieces.

Unique Portraits & Landscapes

A great introductory class for the next Picasso! Explore many painting techniques and learn basic color mixing. This is an excellent class to learn all about the world of art!

Open Art Studio

This introductory class is perfect for the budding artist. Students will learn techniques using basic shapes and forms to propel their drawings to the next level.



Ceramic Hand Building

Two weeks of fun with clay! Learn ceramic hand building techniques while creating objects inspired by nature and current exhibits. Your unique drawings and ideas will become clay sculptures that are glazed and fired! **Each session is limited to 10 students.*

Street Art

Explore creating works inspired by street art using various printmaking, painting and stenciling techniques in this **two week** class. Students will be introduced to different styles to create their own hand held street art in a fun and collaborative atmosphere.

Comic Book Design

Students will learn fine points of designing comics including character creation, storyboard design, drawing techniques and plot development. A lively discussion of the history of comic books and their characters adds to the fun.

Jewelry Design

Learn how to use jewelry making tools and techniques of stringing beads, adding closures and connecting pieces with jump rings. Students will also experiment with polymer clay to make their own beads.

Cosplay Costumes and Props

Students will have **two full weeks** to create Cosplay costume pieces and props. Explore working with existing garments, found objects and hand sewing. Learn carving, construction and painting techniques which will bring your props and costumes to life.

Drawing Techniques & Tricks

Drawing is key to all visual art mediums. Line, shape, perspective, proportion and shading will be shared through a variety of techniques using pencil and charcoal.

Fabric Painting & Design

Learn about color, texture, composition, and shapes in this out of the ordinary designing class. Artists experiment with paint and collaging to design their own unique fabrics.

Making a Masterpiece

Learn from the masters in this class, where students spend the week recreating famous works of art inspired by master artists such as Picasso, Van Gogh and Frida Kahlo.

Art of the Animal

This fun class will help you master the basics of drawing animals. Explore the creative side of the natural world and develop techniques to bring your creations to life.



Teen Comic Book

A comic book class just for teens! Students will spend time in the studio developing their own stories and design their own comic book characters.

Teen Ceramics

Artists will spend **two weeks** creating in the ceramic studio, focusing on how to make fun pieces while working on the wheel and using hand building exercises.

Mural Art

Dive into painting and express your inner self! This **two week** class is for students who want to explore how paintings in public spaces. Students will complete a collaborative wall painting under guidance of a professional muralists.

Interior Design

Students build their own miniature structures that explore interior designing. Students use their creative mind to decide what your Interior design will look like.

Optical Illusions

Learn all about how to design your own optical illusions. Use color, light and patterns to create images that trick the mind into seeing things that are not really there.

Art Journaling

Discover how to use different materials to your advantage when art journaling! Get messy during journal making with collage, painting and sketching.

Computer Animation

Learn the basics of animation and create art in motion. Learn to make a character walk and talk. **laptop and 3 button mouse required, limited laptops for rent. Find and install Blender at www.blender.org*

Illustration and Design

Students will discover perspective and how to map out the proportions of figures and faces. They will also work in mixed media and print designs!

Fantasy Illustration

Students will use their imaginations to create illustrations of incredible characters such as faeries, aliens, monsters, dragons, warriors and superheroes. Students will have fun exploring sketching, color mixing, anatomy and composition using traditional media in class.

Web Design

This introduction class looks at design, creation and maintenance of web pages and websites. Learn advanced techniques, graphic design and how to manage files to end the week with a fully functional website.

3-D Modeling

Learn the basics of 3-D computer modeling with free and open source software, Blender. Learn tools used to create beautiful digital art, animation, games and 3-D printing. **laptop and 3 button mouse required, limited laptops for rent. Find and install Blender at www.blender.org*

Video Game Design

Students will learn the basics of game design and create interactive content with the Unity game engine. No coding skills required. Laptop and 3 button mouse required, limited laptops for rent. Find and install Unity at www.unity3d.org

Video Production

Learn the "how to's" of creating your own videos including pre-production, editing, sound and camera work. Shoot, edit and share on social media. Video camera not required!

Digital Photography

Learn to use a digital camera to its best advantage from a professional photographer. Master basic editing skills in Lightroom, and Photoshop. Camera required.
